Scholastic Book Fair





PISA Glossary

If you're new to us, there may be a few PISA terms and phrases that you've not heard beforeif so; here's a handy guide to our PTA lingo; once you've got these down, you'll be speaking like a native before you know it!

Forfeit Day - A mufti/own clothes day in which the children bring in a donation for the upcoming School fair; each class is responsible for a different 'category'; i.e. if your child is in Year 2 they'll be asked to bring something for the Adult Tombola stall.

The Wrapping Room - A stall at the Christmas Fair at which children can choose a present (and have it wrapped) for their grown-up. Slots here are pre-booked prior to the Fair.

Fair Tokens - PISA Fairs (both Summer and Christmas) are predominantly cash-free affairs and tokens can be purchased before the event.

The Great PISA Sewing Bee

As part of our efforts to be a more sustainably-minded PTA, we've come up with an idea that might help put old school uniform, that can't be passed on - and has seen better days, to use... we've decided to make Petersfield Infant School bunting!

So, alongside this newsletter, you'll find a bunting template/guide from which you can cut out a pennant flag of old uniform (summer dresses and thinner fabrics will work particularly well). Once you've done this, you can either drop your flag/s into the Office, in an envelope marked 'PISA Bunting', or you can start to sew your pieces together at home to make some bunting!
