"Calling any IBMer parents/carers out there!

As you'll likely know, IBM encourages us to volunteer our time to various causes and, when we do, we can track our volunteer hours here: https://ibm.benevity.org/dashboard.

The great thing is, by tracking your volunteer hours, you earn cash to donate to one of the registered charities.

PISA have recently worked hard to become one of the registered charities on the list; so, by volunteering my time over the last year or so to weekly support at my son's Beavers Group, I just donated £550 to PISA!!

It was that simple! I had already taken the time to volunteer so all that was left to do was to donate!

DOES YOUR EMPLOYER OFFER MATCH FUNDING?


